## **Uniform Expectations & Requirements**

The standard of dress worn by students of any school reflects something of the standards of the school. Students who are well dressed are a powerful and positive testimony to any school, while the reverse is also true.

- Correct uniform must be worn at all times
- All uniform items must be kept clean and in good condition. Items with holes, tears, or stains must be quickly repaired or replaced.
- All school uniform and personal property must be clearly marked with the name of its owner.
- Girls' skirts/dresses must touch at least the upper part of the knee
- Students are not permitted to wear make-up. Upon request, senior secondary students may be given permission to wear moderate make-up. Nail polish is not permitted.
- Students' hair must be their natural colour. No coloured streaks are permitted. Hair styles should not
  follow extremes of fashion and should be appropriate to school activities. Senior secondary students
  may be given permission for moderate variations in hair colour but must check with the principal
  before any variations take place.
- Girls' hair must be off the face and fringes should be cut above the eyebrows. Ribbons, bands, clips, in one of the school colours only may be worn.
- Boys' hair must be off the collar and ears, fringes must be cut above the eyebrows, and hair length must be above the ears and collar line.
- No jewellery is allowed except:
  - A wristwatch
  - Girls way wear one plain stud in each ear. No other piercings are permitted.
- Boys are not permitted to have piercings of any kind.
- Boys must be clean shaven
- No tattoos are permitted, either permanent or temporary

## Summer uniform and hats must be worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Winter uniform must be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

A "changeover period" is observed for several weeks in early Spring and Autumn. Either summer or winter uniform may be worn during these weeks as the weather dictates. Notification of the start and finish of the changeover period will be provided in the College newsletter.
